



## What can paper do?


This book concisely explains—and actively demonstrates with six functional pop-up paper contraptions-the science at play in our everyday world.

Consider this book an interactive field guide to the invisible: play with aspects of our world that are usually abstractions, like light, sound, time, and space.







Turn on a light and stargaze with a PLANETARIUM.
